Canadian Leaders Call on Trudeau to Resign

Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's popularity continues to [sink to new lows](#), with Jagmeet Singh, leader of the New Democratic Party (NDP), calling for his resignation yesterday, [stating in a post on X](#):

It's time for Justin Trudeau to resign. Liberals are fighting each other — when Canadians need a Prime Minister who will fight for them. It is more important than ever for people to stand together to fight the threat of Conservative cuts.

The pressure on Trudeau to resign follows the abrupt resignation of Finance Minister Chrystia Freeland yesterday [after a disagreement in how to respond](#) to tariffs proposed by U.S. President-elect Donald Trump.
