# Johnson Cancels Vote After Massie Opposes Temporary Funding Bill

On Monday, Representative Thomas Massie (R-Ky.) [voiced opposition to a temporary spending bill](#) that would fund the federal government for six months. Describing the SAVE Act [[the Safeguard American Voter Eligibility Act](#)] as a “shiny object,” he questioned why it was attached to the spending bill, and said the continuing resolution does not cut spending, [stating on X](#):

With small majorities, that’s what you do. We’re having thoughtful conversations, family conversations within the Republican conference and I believe we’ll get there.”
