Belgian Police Attempt to Shut Down National Conservatism Conference

Socialist party Mayor of the Brussels-Capital Region municipality of Saint-Josse-ten-Noode, Emir Kir, <u>attempted to shut down</u> <u>the National Conservatism Conference</u> featuring Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orbán, former Polish Prime Minister Mateusz Morawiecki, and founder of the U.K. Brexit Party Nigel Farage.

Kir said he ordered the police to shut the event down in the interest of public safety, stating on X:

I issued an order from the Mayor to ban the "National Conservatism Conference" event to guarantee public safety.

In Etterbeek, Brussels City and Saint-Josse, the far-right is not welcome.

Belgian Prime Minister Alexander De Croo stated that Kir violated the Belgian constitution, <u>posting on</u> \underline{X} :
