



Trump Criminal Trial Begins Today

Former President Donald Trump's "hush money" criminal trial began in New York today, with Prosecutor Matthew Colangelo saying in his opening statement, "The defendant, Donald Trump, orchestrated a criminal scheme to corrupt the 2016 presidential election." He claimed Trump falsified invoices: "The defendant disguised his reimbursements to Michael Cohen through 11 falsified invoices, 12 falsified ledger entries, and 11 falsified checks."
