UN Security Council Passes Gaza Ceasefire Resolution

The UN Security Council [passed a resolution calling for a ceasefire](#) in Gaza earlier today. Fourteen of the council members voted for the resolution, with the United States abstaining, allowing the resolution to pass by not using its veto.

The UN announced the resolution, [stating on X](#), "In favour: 14 Against: 0 Abstention: 1 The UN Security Council has adopted a resolution demanding an immediate ceasefire in Gaza and the immediate, unconditional release of all hostages."

After the vote, Israel's Minister of Foreign Affairs Israel Katz [stated on X](#), "The State of Israel will not [cease] fire. We will destroy Hamas and continue to fight until the last of the abductees returns home."
