




Unhinged Radio Host Attacks Former NFL Player for Supporting Trump

Brown responded to Shapiro's defamatory claims that he is "illiterate," acknowledging the radio host's diatribe is often how leftists react when black men don't support Democratic Party candidates, stating in a post on X:

Shapiro responded to Brown, maintaining he stands by every word he said, and alleged Brown accused him of "being a racist" for pointing out the reality that black men are being insulted by leftists for supporting Trump, stating in a post on X:
