@ 21:48 | A \$42 million gun buyback program in Canada has yielded zero guns, a total embarrassment to Trudeau’s statist government.

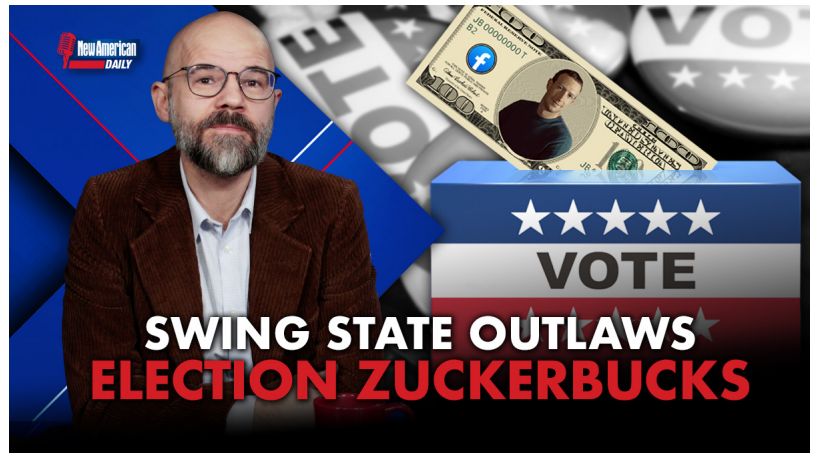
