The U.S. Supreme Court: Enemy of the Constitution? | Beyond the Cover

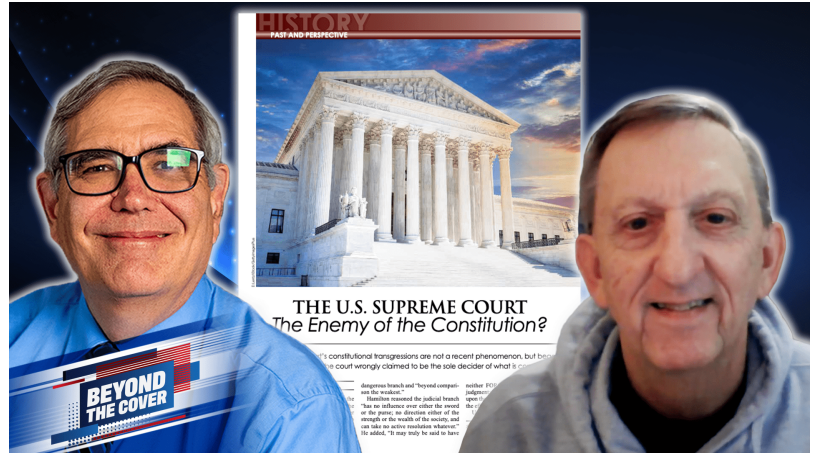
