



Trump 2020 “False Electors” Indicted in Arizona

Arizona Attorney General Kris Mayes announced yesterday that a grand jury has indicted 18 individuals involved in an effort by alternate or so-called fake electors to change the certification of the 2020 presidential election in Arizona, claiming former President Donald Trump as the winner. In a [press release by Mayes office](#), the charges they are facing were announced: “Charges include fraud, forgery, and conspiracy — class 2, 4, and 5 felonies.”

The individuals named as defendants were listed in a press release by Mayes office: “The following individuals are named as defendants in the indictment: Kelli Ward, Tyler Bowyer, Nancy Cottle, Jacob Hoffman, Anthony Kern, James Lamon, Robert Montgomery, Samuel Moorhead, Lorraine Pellegrino, Gregory Safsten, and Michael Ward. Additional named defendants have been indicted but redacted from the attached copy. An unredacted version of the indictment will be made available after all defendants have been served.”
