Conservatism Is Not Constitutionalism

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A common misconception among well-meaning, patriotic Americans is that “conservatism” is the condition we should strive to maintain or restore. This, in large part, is because for many decades the Right served as the ramshackle home for defeatist — and oftentimes unconstitutional — policy and culture ideologies espoused by thought leaders such as William F. Buckley and Russell Kirk.
