



## Dr. Peter McCullough: Preserve Your Bodily Autonomy

Dr. McCullough said that the U.S. health authorities allowed for American lives to perish needlessly by refusing to endorse the early treatment protocols with outstanding safety and efficacy profiles. Moreover, a suppression of early treatment was done intentionally to promote suffering and fear, with the goal of getting Americans to accept the vaccines at all costs. Dr. Peter McCullough is an internist, cardiologist, epidemiologist, who manages the cardiovascular complications of both the viral infection and the injuries developing after the COVID-19 vaccine.

Since the outset of the pandemic, Dr. McCullough has been a leader in the medical response to the COVID-19. In collaboration with other prominent physicians, he published a study on <u>Early Outpatient Treatment of SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) Infection</u> in the American Journal of Medicine and subsequently <u>updated</u> in Reviews in Cardiovascular Medicine. That treatment, if implemented by the U.S. health authorities, could prevent up to 95 percent of hospitalizations and deaths, says the doctor.
