



LINDELL CYBER SYMPOSIUM: SD Senator "Absolutely Convinced There Was Election Fraud"

There is too much evidence to ignore showing that there was widespread fraud in the 2020 elections, South Dakota Senator Julie Frye-Mueller tells The New American magazine's Senior Editor Alex Newman at the Lindell Cyber Symposium.
