Government “Schools” Raising Woke & Illiterate Activists: Chicago Teacher Blows Whistle

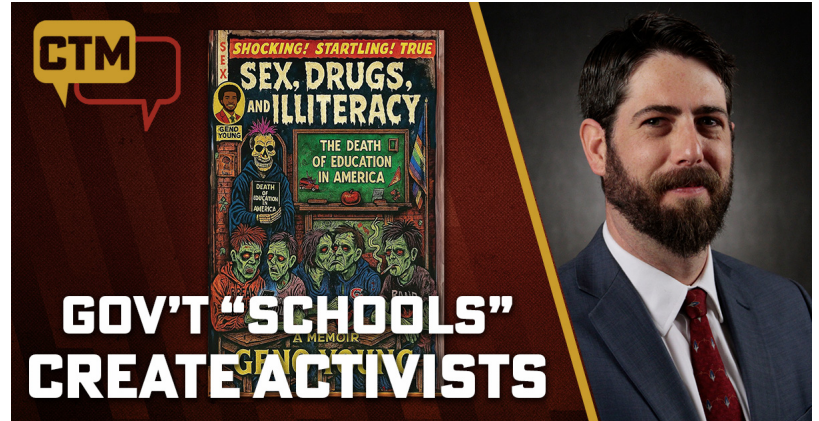
