

Professor Advocates Totalitarianism to Solve "Climate Crisis"

MADRID - Speaking at the United Nations "COP25" Climate Conference, a professor of "environmental science" in Spain advocated totalitarian government to fight against bad weather he claims is caused by human emissions of CO2. These measures imposed by government should include forcing people to use public transportation, limiting the number of births, limiting meat consumption, and more. "This is brutal, nobody would vote for somebody like this," he acknowledged, saying humanity was heading for a "Malthusian catastrophe" that required desperate measures.
