Congressman Tom Tiffany on U.S. Sovereignty, Communist China, and Wisconsin

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Representative Tom Tiffany (R-Wis.) discusses his legislative efforts to protect U.S. sovereignty from globalist international bodies, such as the World Health Organization and World Trade Organization and tackling foreign influence in U.S. universities through his proposed Colleges for the American People Act. Rep. Tiffany discusses the importance to ending foreign worker and migration loopholes with H1 visas on college campuses and in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, where mainland Chinese nationals go and overstay their visas, get drivers licenses and attempt to enter neighboring Guam and the United States mainland. He further discusses how pregnant women from mainland China will go to the CNMI and give birth so their child would get U.S. citizenship, as means of entry into the country. Host Christian Gomez also asks about Congressman Tiffany whether Congress will investigate the immediate and sudden death of CNMI Governor Arnold Palacios amidst his calls to investigate public corruption on the island possibly linked to Communist China. The interview concludes with Rep. Tiffany's call for Canada to resolve and extinguish its wildfires amidst their hazardous impact on the air quality in Wisconsin, Michigan, and other Upper Midwest states.





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
